Who is eligible?

Apartment dwellers, homeowners, and renters — disabled persons and/or those aged 60 years and older who need assistance with housecleaning or minor home repairs in order to maintain a safe, healthy home. Persons who lack other means of obtaining services are particularly encouraged to use the program.

Services are provided in Waterbury, Southbury, Woodbury, Bethlehem, Watertown, Middlebury, Wolcott, Cheshire, Prospect, Thomaston, Naugatuck and Beacon Falls.



What is the cost of the service?

You will be expected to provide all cleaning supplies/equipment and to pay for any materials installed in your home.

Qualified persons age 60 and older are asked to make a contribution for worker services based upon income.
