Through the Rise program, we are expanding our capacity for distributing adult incontinence supplies. We are creating and managing strategic partnerships and pipelines, and identifying the most efficient ways to get these supplies to low-income adults who can't otherwise access them.

Incontinence is a common condition among adults, but many don't seek treatment for it, partly out of embarrassment. Incontinence supplies provide a simple and effective solution to the problem, but they can be costly - particularly for adults living on a fixed income. The price tag can be a severe barrier for low-income individuals, who have limited budgets.

We are dedicated to giving people access to basic needs throughout their lifespan and incontinence products are a very basic – and very personal – need that no one should have to go without.
